MENS CHAMPIONSHIPS 2017
CONDITIONS OF PLAY / ENTRY**

- All games will be played under Bowls NSW Conditions of Play
- **National, State and Zone events only** will take precedence as per Bowls NSW
- **Play or forfeit rule will apply.**
- Bowlers may be require to play **up to two (2) rounds per day**, enabling the Championships to be finalised within intended time frame.
- **The Bowls Manager or his nominee/s reserves the right to use AM Saturdays and evenings** to ensure completion of Championships.
- No umpire will be available for players / teams who arrange their games outside of set playing dates.
- In the event of inclement weather the Bowls Manager or his nominee/s reserves the right to use the next available date/s to complete the Championships within a reasonable time.
- If there is any doubt due to inclement weather; it is the responsibility of the players to ascertain if play is possible; **if it is possible players must attend the Club.** If AM game is washed out it may be played in the PM.

Markers for Singles:

- (a) 1st round matches – list on the notice board asking for markers
 - (b) Losers from any Singles games (Major, Minor, Over 70's) must make themselves available to mark future rounds
 - (c) Any player, who does not fulfil his commitment from marking, unless arranged with the Bowls Office, may be banned from entering future events.

- **Championships matches may be played (day or evening) before the next nominated playing dates by mutual consent.**
 - Any appeals for postponement must be in writing or notified personally to the Bowls Manager five (5) days before the next playing date.
 - Substitute By-Law 2-1: A substitute may play in any position other than Skip.
 - **Before entering any Club Championship it is the player's responsibility to be able to comply with all the above conditions and dates.**
 - The Controlling Body (Bowls Manager or his nominee/s for the day) may alter the Conditions of Play to ensure the successful conclusion of the events.
